Vivaldi's universally popular Four Seasons has become one of the most recorded pieces of classical music. The four concertos, with their virtuoso part for solo violinist, depict the changing seasons in a pastoral landscape with dazzling variety. Vivaldi evokes not only the changing atmospheric conditions, for example the dripping rain represented by the *pizzicato* violins in the second movement of Winter, but bird calls and animal cries, swaving grass, bubbling brooks, and human events such as
