

Uri Caine, born in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, is one of the few artists who is at home in jazz clubs, vaudeilles and classical concert halls. Caine is a knowledgeable great master of both serious and light music. His artistic creativity and joy of experimentation seem to be boundless. He reworks the repertoire of the **Tin Pan Alley** and from the **Great American Songbook**. Through his adaptations and new interpretations do not only **Johann Sebastian Bach**, **Robert Schumann** and **Giuseppe Verdi** sound unexpectedly new but also **George Gershwin** and not to forget **Gustav Mahler**. He interprets, adapts, arranges and carries on the music of Mahler. The sensitive and deep bow of the New York jazz musician Uri Caine to the great classical composers offers profound insights and opens up new vistas. Throughout the decades Caine has preserved his original style and singular sound language.

However that shows only one side of this unique and most impressive artist. He is not only the master of adaptation and re-composition, he is also a renowned composer of jazz and New Music and one of the greatest living jazz musicians and band leaders of our time. The **Shortlist**, compiled by **Stefan Winter**, presents highlights from 1992 - 2015. Uri Caine is a builder of bridges between different worlds of music. He unites jazz, Latin, popular, classical, New and Jewish music to a unique work of art.

Uri Caine ist einer der wenigen Künstler, der in Jazzclubs, Varietés und klassischen Konzertsälen gleichermaßen zu Hause ist. Caine ist ein kundiger, faszinierender Meister der Ernsten (E) und Unterhaltenden (U) Musik. Seine künstlerische Kreativität und

seine Freude am Experimentieren scheinen grenzenlos zu sein. Er befasst sich mit den Werken der **Tin Pan Alley** und aus dem **Great American Songbook**. In seinen Interpretationen klingen nicht nur **J. S. Bach** und **Schumann** unerwartet neu, sondern auch **Gershwin** und nicht zu vergessen **Gustav Mahler**. Er interpretiert, adaptiert, arrangiert und führt die Musik Gustav Mahlers weiter. Die einfühlsame und tiefe Verbeugung des New Yorker Jazzmusikers Uri Caine vor grossen Komponisten der Klassik bietet unerwartete Einblicke. Durch die Jahrzehnte hat Caine sich seinen individuellen

Stil und seine Klangsprache bewahrt. Doch das ist nur eine Seite dieses singulären Künstlers. Er ist nicht allein der Meister der Adaption, er ist auch ein großartiger Komponist und einer der bedeutendsten lebenden Jazzpianisten unserer Zeit. Die **Shortlist**, zusammengestellt von Musikproduzent **Stefan Winter** präsentiert musikalische Höhepunkte aus den Jahren 1992 - 2015. Uri Caine vereint Jazz, Latin, populäre, klassische, Neue und jüdische Musik zu einem einzigartigen Gesamtwerk.
